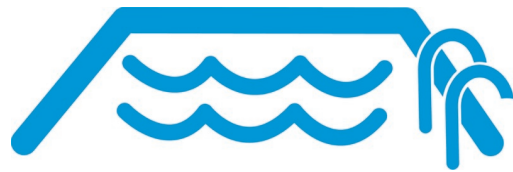

YMCA Lifeguard Certification Course



This course is designed to provide the participants with the knowledge and skills needed to be a lifeguard and professional rescuer. Participants will be certified in ASHI CPR Pro/AED for the Professional Rescuer, Basic First Aid, Emergency Oxygen Administration and YMCA lifeguarding.

Deadline to pay for course is Friday August 5th (**must** take a prerequisite swim before paying for course!)

Prerequisites

Must be 16 years or older by the last day of the course. Must pass prerequisite swim in order to enroll for course. Prerequisite Swim Days and Times (have to attend 1 only):

Friday May 127:00pm (or contact Kathy LaFountain to schedule a different time)

Must bring eLearning completion certificates for both ASHI and YMCA Lifeguarding to first day of class. eLearnings are classes taken on the internet prior to class and take approximately 6 hours total to complete. The eLearning information will be given to you after completion of your prerequisite swim
