Terms of Use & Guidelines for “Commenting” on Posts

Maumee City Schools social media pages focus on celebrating and supporting our students, schools, staff as well as share important news and communicate event information. Community members are encouraged to share their support, connect with other supporters, and visit frequently for news and updates.

Community members are welcome to leave comments but should do so with the understanding that the district’s first priority is to protect students, staff and community members.

Maumee City Schools does not respond to comments made on district social media sites. If an individual has a question they want to have answered, they should reach out through traditional communication channels. Below is a list of the types of comments that will be deleted from district social media channels:

- Cyberbullying comments
- Comments that are specifically discriminatory or derogatory to individual student(s), groups of students, teams, clubs/activities, staff or community members
- Political, racist, sexist, abusive, violent/threatening, obscene, and inappropriate comments
- Spam and trolling comments
- Comments that are unlawful, misleading, or fraudulent
- Comments attempting to sell products or promote commercial endeavors
- Comments unrelated to post content
